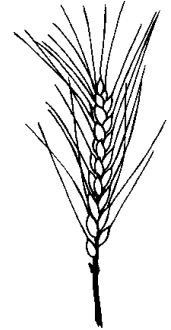


PLANT & SEED ID JUDGING
