POLICY ON 600A FORMS

- 1. Certain 4-H events require the member to turn in a completed 600A form. A completed 600A form will include all information requested relative to each individual 4-H member plus the signature of the 4-H member and the member's parent or legal guardian.
- 2. The 600A form has a three-fold purpose. First, it allows the member to be treated at a medical facility when parents cannot be contacted. The medical person administering treatment also is aware of any allergies or other dangerous conditions the member may have. Secondly, it is a contract signed by the member and parent stating that the member will adhere to certain rules of conduct. Third, it also includes a Publicity Release.
- 3. An agent should under no circumstance allow a 4-H member to participate in the following events without a completed 600A form:

All-Stars4-H CampExchange TripsAll State EventsRegion Livestock JudgingRegion Horse JudgingRegion and State Horse & Livestock Shows*Any overnight county, region or state event (retreats, lock-ins, etc.)

- 4. If a member shows up to an event without a completed 600A form, the member's agent present at the event will be asked to either:
 - a. Make arrangements to get a completed 600A form by driving back or meeting parents, etc. or
 - b. Take the 4-H member(s) back home until they return with a completed form.
- 5. If a member(s) shows up to an event without a completed 600A form and the member's agent is not present, the agent will be contacted and asked to deal with the situation as defined in number "4."
- 6. WHEN IN DOUBT, HAVE MEMBER(S) COMPLETE A 600A FORM.

*This will be in effect when members are attending these events without their parents. If parents are attending **these** events with their children...the parents assume responsibility for their children.
