

Election of Elder and At-Large Scouts at Spring Conference

The following is the process that will be followed concerning the election of the Elder and At-Large Scouts onto the Eastern Region All Star Council.

1. To be considered for either of these positions the prospective candidate must complete the All Star Officer Application and have it in to Kim Spangler at the Eastern Region office by the deadline announced on the conference brochure. Applications should be scanned and emailed but must be completed.
2. To be considered for either of these positions the prospective candidate must not have served as that specific officer in the past. (If the prospective candidate has been an At-large scout they can run for Elder Scout or vice-versa. If they have already been an Elder Scout or an At-Large they cannot run for that same position again).
3. All officers will need to review the Online Officer Video. The link to this will be given to them after the application deadline and must be watched prior to conference.
4. Prospective candidates must declare at the Saturday Morning Business meeting the office for which they intend interview.
5. Prospective candidates for either of these positions may **not** run for another All Star Position on Saturday.
6. The interviews will be conducted by at least two All Star Advisors and the outgoing Regional All Star Chief after elections on Saturday. After interviews are conducted decisions will be made as to who will be appointed to those positions.
7. The appointed Elder and At-Large Scout will be tapped in during the installation ceremony along with the other top four officers at the All Star campfire on Saturday night.
8. If eligible, those candidates who were not selected for either of these positions may run for the Area Scout position in their prospective multi-county Area.
