

HONOR CLUB ORGANIZATION

The Tennessee 4-H Honor Club is a program designed to provide recognition and leadership development for Jr. High and Sr. High 4-H members. This organization does not meet on a State or Region level. Traditionally it has been a very important service organization. The organization generally meets on a regular basis and has a full slate of officers. Requirements:

1. Members must be junior high or senior 4-H members as of date of initiation.
2. Members must have completed at least two years of 4-H work, including current year.
3. Members must be serving as junior or teen leaders.

Membership:

1. Membership is open to any qualified junior high or senior high member.
2. Member must complete an application for membership. The application (SP95) must be written in member's own handwriting.
3. A score of 200 points on the application as well as the proper total of points in leadership, etc. is required before the application for membership can be considered.
4. An application can be sent to the state for approval after January 1st of the member's 6th grade year.
5. Recommendations for membership shall be approved by the county 4-H agents, then forwarded to the State 4-H office for final approval.

Honor Club membership is required to be an All Star or to run for State Office at Congress or Roundup.
