COVID-19 Precautions for Clover Classic 2021

- This is an indoor/outdoor event.
- Participants will be asked to wear a mask while on the grounds except while mounted.
- Participants, family members, and spectators are encouraged to social distance. Announcements reinforcing this will be made during the event and signage will be posted throughout the event space.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up at various spots.
- A funnel cake trailer sponsored by Faith N Friends Horse Rescue and the concession stand on the mezzanine will be the only food available for sale. You may bring your own food and snacks but please do not set up community buffets.
- Please avoid congregating at the bleachers. Signage will also be present on the bleachers encouraging social distancing and for participants to stay in family units.
- It is encouraged that participants stay in their own groups during any breaks.

- Check in area will be at the barn. Please do not congregate at this area. We will get everyone checked in as soon as possible.
- A health screening will be conducted by Roane State at the guard shack.

- A list of participants and spectators will be kept by show leadership.

RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR 4H SHOW EXHIBITORS

2021 Clover Classic

Danny Bullington: Show Manager

1. Exhibitors must be a 4H member in grades 4 – 12 and may only show in all Walk/Trot or Walk/Trot/Canter classes. No W/T/C riders will be allowed to show in W/T classes. This rule applies to the rider. No exceptions.
2. Dogs on show grounds must be leashed – no dogs in the arenas.
3. Exhibitors shall act as ladies and gentlemen at all times. It is mandatory that exhibitors be polite, good sportsmen, and properly attired in clean and neat clothing. **Elimination for infraction of this rule shall be at the discretion of the show committee.** Parents and/or chaperones and supporters of an exhibitor must conduct themselves in a proper manner according to 4H objectives of good sportsmanship and citizenship. **Improper behavior by parent/chaperone and supporters or trainers can result in the elimination of the exhibitor at the discretion of the Show Manager/Committee.**
4. Exhibitor must be responsible for selection, management and care of his/her horse and exhibitor will be responsible for tack, horse and personal items.
5. All horses/ponies must have a minimum Body Condition Score of 4 to show.
6. No stallions will be permitted. Horses shown in performance classes must be at least three years of age as of January 1 of current year.
7. Only authorized persons will be allowed in the show ring.
8. Exhibitor must be in proper dress for the classes they are showing in. Boots are required.
9. ASTM approved helmets with chin strap properly fastened are required for all 4-H youth while mounted and are considered proper attire for all classes.
10. Adults may request a helmet waiver form from show management. **4-H'ers may not even if they are 18.**
11. Fastening exhibitor's feet/legs to saddle or stirrups WILL NOT BE PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
12. Judge's decisions are final. Any dispute may be submitted to the show committee in writing.
13. **Parents, chaperones and exhibitors may not address judge/judges concerning rules or judging procedures. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in exhibitor and parent/chaperone/trainer dismissal from show grounds and forfeiture of points accrued by exhibitor.**
14. Proof of negative Coggins test must be presented before unloading horses on the day of show.
15. Every animal must be under control at all times and may be disqualified if considered by the judges and/or the show committee to be in any way undesirable, untrained, unfit, or improperly "turned out". If the show committee or judge deems a horse unsafe, the class will be held until the rider is excused. All judges' decisions are final.
16. No adult is allowed to warm up a horse in the ring for a 4-H'er who is showing the horse in that same ring.
17. No changes will be made to classes 1, 2, 29, 30 after 7:45 AM. No changes of any class will be made 2 classes prior to the class that is desired to be changed. Scratches are allowed but no refunds will be made.
18. Horses entered in the country pleasure classes are only eligible to enter showmanship, halter, equitation, and trail. Exhibitors may show in western or English attire but not a combination of both.
19. All fence classes are considered canter classes.
20. Exhibitors in jump classes will be allotted 5 minutes to complete the course. Exhibitors will be excused after 5 minutes or 3 refusals.
21. Other rules as detailed in the TN 4H Horse Show Handbook apply to all competitors.
22. Please keep in mind that the show committee has made every effort to provide a show that will help to prepare 4-H members for the upcoming regional and state shows. Complaints and suggestions should be submitted to the Show committee in writing.
23. Championship Divisions are as follows: A 4-H member may only declare **ONE** highpoint division.

Through community outreach and education, Faith N Friends strives to bring understanding and comfort to people of all ages and from all walks as they interact with and learn about horses.

There are over 150,000 horses, either in rescues or feral, without permanent homes in the United States. More than 90,000 horses each year are sent to slaughter. Rescue horses have fewer options than their kindred dogs and cats, due to their size and feed requirements. ⁽¹⁾

On the human side, interaction with horses provides numerous positive and therapeutic benefits. Equine therapy has been used by children's therapy centers, schools, veterans' groups, correctional facilities, addiction treatment facilities, and trauma centers. These therapies usually don't involve riding. Simply interacting with, grooming, and caring for horses provides advantages. Horses provide a mirror for people. They reflect the care and compassion they are given. They can help a child or adult identify their own emotions and through their care, they can help instill a work ethic and sense of responsibility.⁽²⁾

Faith N Friends works to address both the equine and human needs by providing care, treatment, and training, as well as matching loving owners to the right horse while helping and educating horse owners and the community.
