



Directions

From Knoxville, take I-40 East. At I-40'I-81 split, take I-81 North towards Bristol, take Exit 23 and follow HWY 11-E towards Greeneville (approx. 11 miles), then exit onto HWY 321/70 South.

From Johnson City, take HWY 11-E south to Greeneville. On the west side of Greeneville exit 11-E Business onto HWY 321/70 South.

At the HWY 312/70 exit bottom of ramp, go towards Greeneville to the first traffic light and turn right. Go 2 miles, cross railroad tracks and straight toward traffic light. You are now on HWY 70 south. Travel approx. 5 miles on HWY 70 South. Turn left onto East Allens Bridge Rd. there is a University of Tennessee sign on the right-hand side of the road at this turn and a greenhouse on the left.

Stay on East Allens Bridge Rd for 2 miles. The Research and Education Center is on the left.
