Holston Home is proudly affiliated with the Holston Conference of the United Methodist Church, an area that covers all of East Tennessee, the western-most 17 counties in Virginia, and a little bit of territory in North Georgia. Holston Home is situated on 155 acres of gently rolling hillside in Greeneville, TN. The goal of Holston Home is to help children and families overcome hardships in their lives. Sometimes, children are unable to live at home, and Holston Home provides one. The goal is always to do what is best for the children whether it's reuniting with family, adoption, or successfully transitioning to adulthood.




Directions

From Knoxville, take I-40 East. At I-40/I-81 split, take I-81 North towards Bristol, take Exit 23 and follow HWY 11-E towards Greeneville (approx. 11 miles), then exit onto HWY 321/70 South.

From Johnson City, take HWY 11-E south to Greeneville. On the west side of Greeneville exit 11-E Business onto HWY 321/70 South.

At the HWY 312/70 exit bottom of ramp, go towards Greeneville to the first traffic light and turn right. Go 2 miles, cross railroad tracks and straight toward traffic light. You are now on HWY 70 south. Travel approx. 5 miles on HWY 70 South. Turn left onto East Allens Bridge Rd. there is a University of Tennessee sign on the right-hand side of the road at this turn and a greenhouse on the left.

Stay on East Allens Bridge Rd for 2 miles. The Research and Education Center is on the left.
