**House of Hope

The “House of Hope” is a short-term care facility providing care and services for drug-endangered, abused, and at-risk children. These children have fallen victim to physical, emotional, environmental, and sexual abuse; as well as being exposed to drugs. A large percentage of children brought to the House of Hope is due to their parents’ illegal drug use.

The House of Hope is also dedicated to assist law enforcement and child welfare agencies of the State of Tennessee; as well as educate and inform the public on how to recognize, prevent, protect, and provide aid to children who have become victims of child abuse, neglect, drug endangerment, and any other collateral activity affecting the welfare, health, safety, and protection of children.

The House of Hope depends solely on donations and does not receive any public or government funding.

Our additional programs are created from needs in the community brought to our attention. We will continue to pursue ways to enhance the lives of children and families.

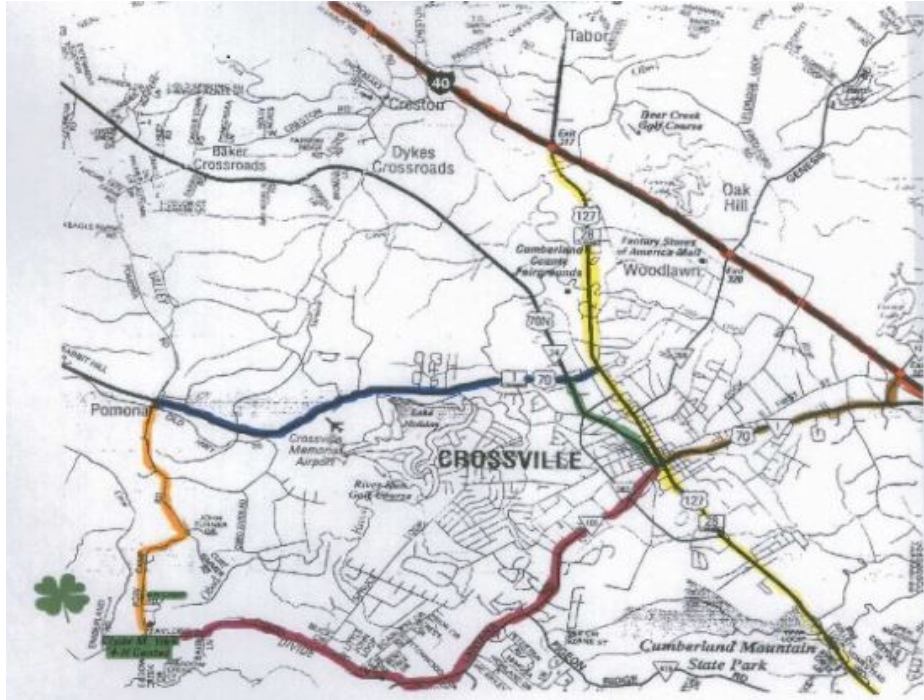

### Directions:

#### Traveling West on I-40

1. Exit I-40 at Exit 317 and take 127 South (turning left from I-40) to the 4th traffic light (Landmark: Bojangle's Chicken on left)
2. Turn RIGHT at light – go straight on Northside Drive to second light which comes to a T at Highway 70.
3. Turn right onto Highway 70 traveling west. Go approximately 4 miles to POW Camp Road (on the left) (Landmark: University of Tennessee sign on left) (Landmark: Pomona Grocery on right)
4. Turn left onto POW Camp Road – go approximately 2.3 miles to the camp (Camp is on left)

#### Traveling East on I-40

1. Exit I-40 at Exit 311 and go right for 1.2 miles at a stop sign at a T.
2. Turn LEFT onto Highway 70. Travel 4.5 miles.
3. Turn RIGHT onto Pomona Road. Travel 3.5 miles to stop sign. (Landmark: Profitt Market on right and Dollar Store on left)
4. Travel across Highway 70 onto POW Camp Road and travel 2.8 miles. Landmark: UT Clyde York sign on right on POW Camp Road Landmark: Pomona Methodist Church on left
5. Camp will be on your left. Enter through the first entrance which is the North entrance.
