

GENERAL RULES FOR JUDGING TEAMS

Full, Three-person, and Incomplete Teams:	<p>A full team consists of four (4) members. A full team will have the luxury of having a drop score. A three-person team can compete but all scores must count putting them at a natural disadvantage. An incomplete team is a team with less than 3 members. This team cannot compete as a team, only as individuals. They cannot place higher than a three-person or full team regardless of their score. The only exception to these rules is with 4-H Grill Master Challenge, which has to have a member in each species.</p>
Teams per County:	<p>There is no limit to the number of judging teams any county can bring for Region competition.</p>
Individuals:	<p>A county may have members compete for individual awards if there are not enough members to make a team. For example: A county has 10 members; this could be two full teams and two individuals.</p>
State Substitution:	<p>A county may substitute for up to two members on a team advancing to a state contest. Substitutions can only come from other teams or individuals who participated in the Region Contest. See Individuals and Teams Above.</p>
All in One State Contest:	<p>A county may substitute for up to two members on a team advancing to a state contest. Substitutions can only come from other teams or individuals who participated in the Region Contest. See Individuals and Teams Above.</p>
