

Eastern Region All-Star Council
Official Position Descriptions
(Effective February 1, 2024)

CHIEF

The Eastern Region Chief is responsible for:

Presiding over all Region Council meetings, business meetings, and awards presentations

Representing his/her region on the executive committee at State High Council.

The Chief will participate in the State All Star Campfire at Roundup.

The Chief is a voting delegate at High Council and is eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years.

The Chief must participate in the following:

Fall Judging Day Contest Award Programs
Spring and Fall All Star Conference
State High Council
State All Star Conference (Roundup)
Congress Readiness Day
Regional Public Speaking Contest
Roundup Readiness Day

The All Star must have served at least one year on the Eastern Region All Star Council or on State 4-H Council in order to run for Chief.

**** In order to run for any State All Star Office the member must have been an All Star for two years. (They will be eligible to run the second Roundup after their initiation.)**

DEPUTY CHIEF

The Deputy Chief is the equivalent of a Vice-President. The Deputy Chief will preside in the absence of the Chief.

The Deputy Chief is responsible for:

Attending all region functions as representative for the Eastern Region.

Presiding over meetings in the absence of the Chief.

Maintaining and update the Eastern Region All-Star Webpage.

Organizing evaluations for all conferences.

The Deputy Chief will participate in the State All Star Campfire at Roundup.

The Deputy Chief is a voting delegate at High Council and is eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years

The Deputy Chief must participate in the following:

- All Star Planning Retreats
- Fall Judging Day Contest Award Programs
- Spring and Fall All Star Conference
- State High Council
- State All Star Conference (Roundup)
- Congress Readiness Day
- Regional Public Speaking Contest
- Roundup Readiness Day

The All Star must have been initiated at a prior All Star Conference in order to run for Deputy Chief.

**** In order to run for any State All Star Office the member must have been an All Star for two years. (They will be eligible to run the second Roundup after their initiation.)**

SCRIBE

The Scribe is responsible for:

Taking of minutes at meetings, typing them and providing a copy to all council members.

Preparing an All Star report to be given at High Council.

Maintaining the Regional All Star Team Site and posting information, minutes, and such on the team site.

The Scribe will participate in the State All Star Campfire at Roundup.

The Scribe is a voting delegate at High Council and is eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years

The Scribe must participate in the following:

- All Star Planning Retreats
- Fall Judging Day Contest Award Programs
- Spring and Fall All Star Conference
- State High Council
- State All Star Conference (Roundup)
- Congress Readiness Day
- Regional Public Speaking Contest
- Roundup Readiness Day

The All Star must have been initiated at a prior All Star Conference in order to run for Scribe.

**** In order to run for any State All Star Office the member must have been an All Star for two years. (They will be eligible to run the second Roundup after their initiation.)**

EAGLE SCOUT

The Eagle Scout's is responsible for:

Working with and maintaining the list of new initiates for each conference.

Filling in for higher officers in event of absence.

Serving as the Parliamentarian and ensuring that all business meetings follow Robert's Rules of Order.

The Eagle Scout is a voting delegate at High Council and is eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years.**

Eagle Scouts must participate in the following:

- All Star Planning Retreats
- Fall Judging Day Contest Award Programs
- Spring and Fall All Star Conference
- State High Council
- State All Star Conference (Roundup)
- Congress Readiness Day
- Regional Public Speaking Contest
- Roundup Readiness Day

The All Star must have been initiated at a prior All Star Conference in order to run for Eagle Scout.

**** In order to run for any State All Star Office the member must have been an All Star for two years. (They will be eligible to run the second Roundup after their initiation.)**

ELDER SCOUT

This position will be selected by the Eastern Region All Star Advisors based on an interview conducted at the conference. Candidates wishing to run for this office will need to complete an officer application and have it turned in by the officer application deadline. Candidates will be asked after the completion of the campfire on Saturday night if they still wish to be considered. Interviews will be set-up with decisions made prior to Area Scout elections on Sunday Morning.

The Elder Scout's responsibilities include:

Providing help to and presiding over area scouts.

Serving as contact for county agents and area scouts.

Taking photos at all events to be used for promotional purposes

Assisting in all activities as needed.

The Elder Scout is a voting delegate at High Council and is eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years.**

The All Star must have been initiated at a prior All Star Conference in order to run for Elder Scout.

**** In order to run for any State All Star Office the member must have been an All Star for two years. (They will be eligible to run the second Roundup after their initiation.)**

AT-LARGE SCOUT

This position will be selected by the Eastern Region All Star Advisors based on an interview conducted at the conference. Candidates wishing to run for this office will need to complete an officer application and have it turned in by the officer application deadline. Candidates will be asked after the completion of the campfire on Saturday night if they still wish to be considered. Interviews will be set-up with decisions made prior to Area Scout elections on Sunday Morning.

The at-large scouts' responsibilities include:

Providing help to and presiding over area scouts.

Serving as contact for county agents and area scouts.

Taking photos at all events to be used for promotional purposes

Assisting in all activities as needed.

The At-Large Scout is a voting delegate at High Council and is eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years.**

AREA SCOUTS

The Eastern Region will have 4 Area Scouts which may come from any county in the Sub-Region.

Their responsibilities include:

Being readily available to county contacts and county agents in area for sub-regional and county events.

Taking photos at all events to be used for promotional purposes

Assisting in all activities as needed.

Area Scouts are voting delegates at High Council and are eligible to run for State Scribe, State Deputy Chief, or State Chief if they have been an All Star member for two years.**
