# 2025 Eastern Region Swine Show Information



#### **Date and Location**

The Eastern Region Swine Show will be held on **Saturday**, **December 13**, **2025**, at the **Roane State Expo Center**, 276 Patton Lane, Harriman, TN.

#### **Parking**

Ample parking is available directly in front of the Expo Center.

### **Health Papers**

All hogs must have current health papers **before unloading**. **No exceptions.** TDA will also be conducting health checks

#### **Tagging**

All hogs must be **tagged prior to arrival**. Please ensure tags are **clean and legible**. **No exceptions.** 

#### **Entry Forms**

Entry Forms for all hogs must be submitted to county agents.

### **Entry Fee and Registration**

A \$10 entry fee per hog for the Region show will be required to support awards and event costs.

- Maximum of 6 hogs per exhibitor (\$60 maximum per exhibitor).
- Counties will collect fees from exhibitors and will be billed after the show through their county Extension office.
- Additional camper hookup is not included.
- Please note, if counties are participating in a county show the day prior—the fee is an additional \$5.00 per head with the same invoicing process as the Region show.
- Tack stalls are \$24.00 total for this show. Limit one tack stall per exhibitor.
- Animal stalls may house a maximum of three hogs per stall, except in cases where an exhibitor is showing fewer than three hogs.

### Stalls and Cleanup

Stalls will be assigned by county. Exhibitors are responsible for removing trash and raking bedding toward the front of the stall after use.

## **Show Divisions**

#### **Purebred Breeding Gilt and Market Hog Divisions**

- All purebred hogs must be registered and have a farrowing date of June 1 or later.
- Registration papers must be presented at check-in.
- All hogs must have a permanent ear notch and a Tennessee Junior Livestock ear tag.
- Gilts must be guaranteed open (not bred).
- Entries must be **owned by the exhibitor** by the official ownership deadline.
- Accepted breeds: Berkshire, Chester White, Duroc, Hampshire, Hereford, Landrace, Poland China, Spotted, Tamworth, and Yorkshire.
- Breeds with **5+ head and at least 2 exhibitors** will have their own class; others will show in the **All Other Breeds** division.
- Classes will be divided by **farrowing date (gilts)** or **weight (market hogs)** as evenly as possible.
- Breed Champions and Reserves must return for the Overall Champion Drive.

#### **Crossbred Market Hogs**

All crossbred barrows and gilts will show together, divided by weight into three classes.

## **Show Structure**

## **Breeding Gilt Show**

- Purebred Breeding Gilts: Shown by breed and age.
- All Other Breeds: Purebreds without sufficient entries for a separate class.
- Crossbred Breeding Gilts: Shown separately by weight.
- Supreme Champion Breeding Gilt: Selected from all breed champions, including crossbreds.

### **Market Hog Show**

- Purebred Market Hogs: Shown by breed and weight.
- All Other Breeds: Purebreds without sufficient numbers for a separate class.
- Crossbred Market Hogs: All crossbreds shown together by weight.
- Supreme Champion Market Hog: Selected from all breed champions, including crossbreds.

# Weigh-In and Check-In

There will be no Saturday weigh-in or check-in. Scales will remain open Friday, December 12, from 8:00 AM to 6:30 PM ET. All hogs must be in place by 6:30 PM Friday.

### **Awards**

### **Grand and Reserve Champions**

Exhibitors of the **Overall Grand and Reserve Champion Market Hogs and Breeding Gilts** will receive banners.

#### **Premier Exhibitor Award**

Awards will be given to the top exhibitor in each of five age divisions, based on:

- Best pig's placing score
- Showmanship placing score
- Skillathon score

Example scoring:

1st = 100 pts, 2nd = 98 pts, 3rd = 96 pts, etc. Skillathon scores will be the actual score earned.

# **Bedding**

Please bring your own **shavings** to this show as they will not be available.

## **Washing and Grooming**

Outdoor wash racks will NOT be available.

## **County Shows**

County shows may be held **Friday**, **December 12**.

Judge fees are \$5 per pig, billed to counties after the event.

A schedule of county show times will be sent by **Chris Mackey in late November 2025**.

# Weight Requirements

There will be no lightweight division.

- Minimum show weight: 125 lbs
- No shrinkage will be considered.
- Exhibitors with underweight pigs may still participate in **Showmanship** and **Skillathon ONLY**.

### Skillathon

Held to prepare exhibitors for the state contest.
